





Royal Decree 1055/2022 requires companies that put household packaging on the market to take responsibility for processing and paying for the waste generated by said packaging.

This obligation can be met individually or collectively, as is the case of the companies that are part of **Ecoembes**, the non-profit system that is responsible for coordinating and managing the recycling of household plastic, metal, brik, wood, paper and cardboard packaging, from the time it is deposited in a container until it is delivered to a recycling facility to be recycled.

> In order to fulfil this financial obligation, the companies that are part of Ecoembes, pay a Green Dot fee for each packaging item you put on the market.
